To earn a minor in history, a student must satisfactorily complete (with a minimum 2.0 average) a minimum of 18 semester hours of history courses. These 18 hours must include at least 3 hours of credit from three of the four groups of history courses (Groups I-IV). For purposes of the minor, Hist 1004, 1115, and 1116 may be considered as Group I credit; Hist 1024, 1025, and 1026 may be considered as Group II credit; and Hist 1214 and 1224 may be considered as Group III credit. At least 6 of the 18 hours must be on the 2000 level or above, and at least 6 hours must be at the 3000 level or above.
